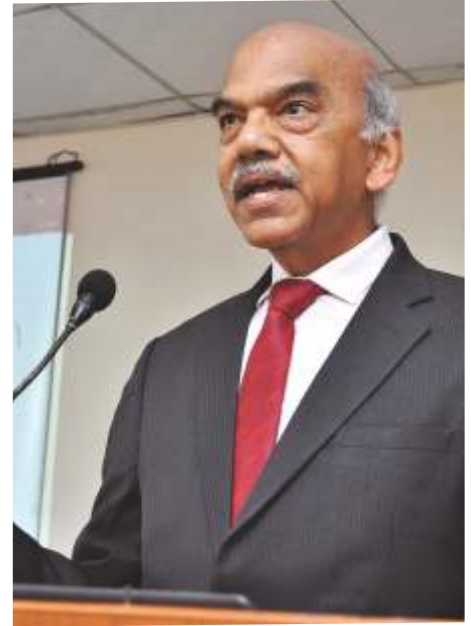

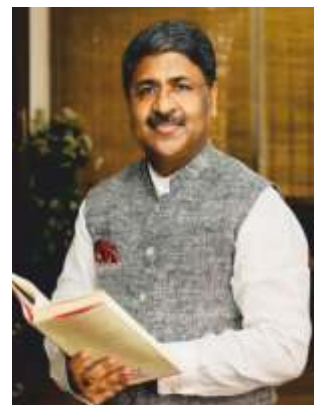

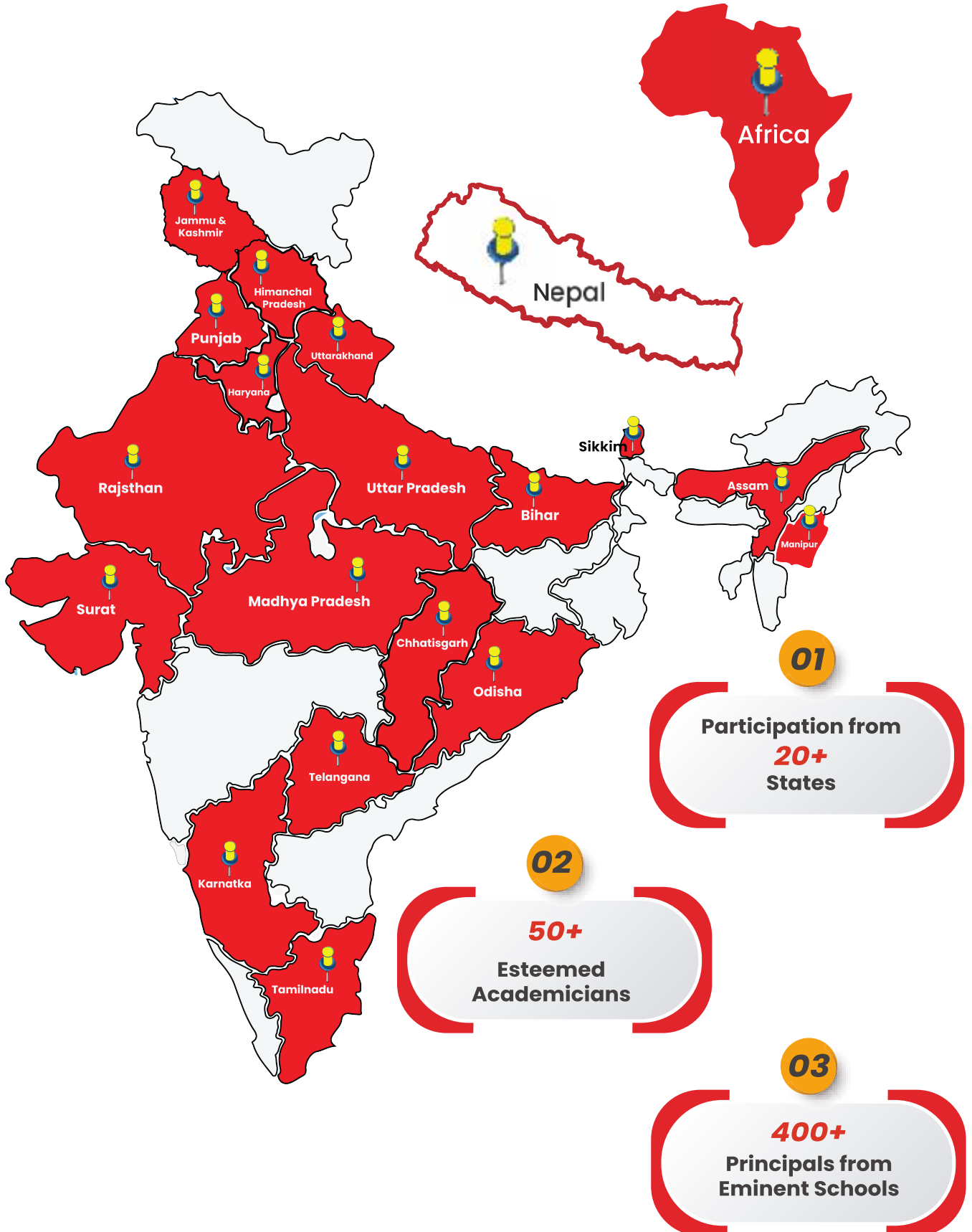

HIGHLIGHTS OF CONCLAVE



A recent survey on career awareness among Indian students aged 14 to 21 unveiled a surprising statistic—93% were familiar with only seven career options, overlooking the vast array of over 250 job choices in India. The known options included law, engineering, medicine, accounts and finance, design, computer applications and IT, and management. This limited awareness poses challenges for both students, who might miss out on suitable opportunities, and companies grappling with unfilled job vacancies. Experts advocate for increased awareness among parents and teachers about the diverse career landscape to guide students effectively, emphasizing that early career counseling at ages 13 to 14 is crucial for informed decision-making.

Out of 250+ career choices, 93% of youth are aware of only 7 career choices

India targeting enrolment of half million foreign students by 2047, says Niti Aayog CEO

India aims to enroll 500,000 foreign students in higher education by 2047, emphasizing the crucial role of Artificial Intelligence for competitiveness. To attract global students, creating more educational cities is essential. The expansion of the higher education ecosystem must prioritize both international and domestic students. While India's education system has a rich heritage, rapid growth necessitates comprehensive reforms to address quality variations. The goal is to become a global education provider by improving quality, brand value, and international rankings. Innovation and revamping the system are imperative for producing industry-ready graduates. Universities, with a 25-year window, play a pivotal role in shaping students' thought processes to harness India's demographic dividend.

49 % of Indian student goes abroad for education.

In 2023, India boasts the highest number of universities globally, with 5,350 and 43,796 colleges, witnessing remarkable growth in the last nine years. Despite this, a surprising 49% of Indian students pursue education abroad. The paradox prompts an exploration of over-tors. India's commitment to expanding educational opportunities is evident in the unprecedented surge of over 5,000 new colleges. However, students seek international education for global exposure, perceived superior quality, specialized courses, emphasis on research, and a global recognition of degrees. To address this, India must focus on enhancing education quality, fostering innovation, and offering specialized programs. Collaborative efforts from educational institutions, policymakers, and industry stakeholders are crucial to create a domestic academic environment that competes globally.

EDUCATION EVOLUTION IN INDIA

52% of students want to opt for tech as career

As India marked National Technology Day, a recent survey by online learning platform Brainly revealed that **52%** of Indian students aspire to build careers in technology. The study found that **72%** of students believe tech-focused subjects like product engineering, data analytics, and coding should be part of the school curriculum. Additionally, **47%** emphasized the increasing importance of learning technology, regardless of one's academic stream. The survey indicates a growing interest in tech concepts, with 54% of students enrolling in tech-related courses during the lockdown. Encouraging a skill-oriented learning approach is crucial to preparing students for a tech-driven future.

Over the last three decades, India has witnessed an unprecedented expansion in its higher education sector, currently accommodating 40.15 million students across 5350 universities, 43,796 colleges, and 11,779 standalone institutions. This is a significant leap from 0.2 million students in about 20 universities and 500 colleges in 1950-51. Despite this growth, the Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) for India stands at 26.7, lower than the world average and developed countries. The National Education Policy 2020 aims for a 50% GER by 2030. This article delves into the challenges and potential solutions for enhancing GER, emphasizing the need to focus on increasing the number of students completing high secondary education for higher education enrollment.

Reaching GER of 50% by 2030 as envisaged in NEP 2020 needs a course correction

70% increase in number of students opting for upskilling courses in the last year

In the past year, there has been a notable **70%** surge in students opting for upskilling courses. Several factors contribute to this trend, including accelerated digitization and the growing need for proficiency in supply chain management, full-stack development, financial services, and cybersecurity. Consequently, the demand for skill proficiency has risen by **25%** in the past year, with expectations of reaching **41% by 2025**. The current wave of layoffs across companies has further intensified the drive for upskilling. Additionally, there is a noticeable increase in learners hailing from tier I and tier II cities.
