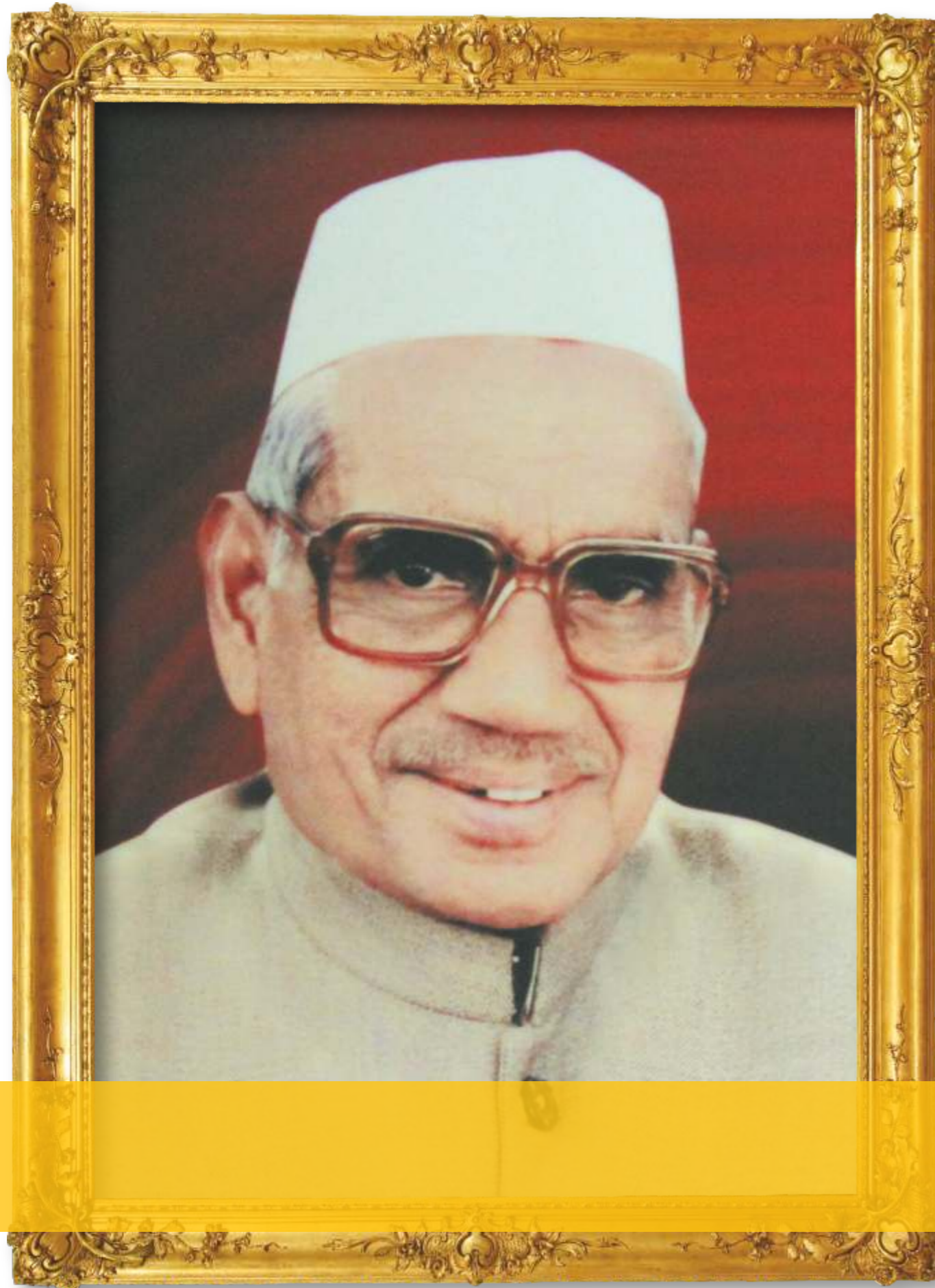

BACHELOR OF AYURVEDIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY (BAMS)

Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) is based on the old and Ancient Ayurvedic Medical system containing the prevention and cure to the body by balancing the harmony of "Vata, Pitta and Kapha".

DEPARTMENTS

Department Of Stri Rog And Prasuti Tantra

Striroga and prasuti tantra deals with management of diseases manifesting specially in women in every stage of life with gynecological and obstetric care.

Department of Kayachikitsa (General Medicine)

Imparts training in the division of General Medicine in Ayurveda. In ancient times, the practice of Ayurveda comprised of the two schools of medicine and surgery. Kayachikitsa, representing the school of medicine forms the basis for all other branches of Ayurvedic treatments and hence this department lays the foundation for shaping a skilled Ayurvedic Physician.

Department of Shalaky Tantra

Imparts training in areas of specialization like ENT, Ophthalmology, Dentistry and diseases of the head. Special training is given on management of certain eye diseases, conditions like sinusitis, migraine and such other conditions for which Ayurvedic treatment is effective.

Department of Shalya Tantra (Surgery)

Deals with the branch of Ayurvedic surgery and provides a basic understanding of the principles of modern surgery. Bone setting, application of medicated thread (ksharasutra) for management of haemorrhoids and fistula, application of leech as well as management of cuts and wounds are the areas of strength in Ayurvedic surgery.

Department of Panchakarma

Deals with the Purification therapies of Ayurveda and provides a basic understanding of the principles of Shodhana. Panchakarma includes Vamana, Virechana, Basti, Nasya & Rakta Mokshan. As far as the treatment methods are concerned Ayurveda has described the use of Shamana (Palliative treatment) and Shodhana (Bio-Purification methods -Panchakarma) methods.

Department Of Sanskrit Samhita Siddhant

"Ayurveda is an ancient science of Indigenous medicine, it is special in respect that it is not only a medical science but an Art of Living in Human being." This is the first and the most important Department of Ayurveda, Also known as Basic principles. This department is concerned with basic principles of Ayurveda which are described in classical texts i.e. Ayurved Samhitas. Samhitas are in Sanskrit language which is a divine language, hence to understand the samhita in their true meanings Sanskrit is also taught by this department along with samhitas (classical texts) in detail.

Department Of Kriya Sharir

It deals with the normal function of human body and its parts. It emphasizes the concepts of Dosha, Dhatu and Malas. According to the Ayurveda every individual is unique entity and for knowing this uniqueness of every individual "prakriti parikshan" that is the analysis of body and mind is the speciality of this subject.

Department of Roga Nidan avam Vikruti Vigyana

This department deals with nosology (classification of diseases) and techniques of diagnosis. Training is given in both ancient methods of diagnosis and relevant modern investigations. Ayurveda lays great stress on detecting diseases in the very early stages of development and has developed an elaborate system of subtle diagnostic techniques to identify imbalances in the body before they transform into complicated disease processes.

Kaumarabhritya (Paediatrics)

Ayurveda offers special treatment modalities for post natal care of the mother. Paediatrics deals with care of the new born as well as diseases affecting children. Traditions of Ayurvedic paediatrics are still alive in India.

Department of Rasashastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana

With the help of well equipped labs, this department imparts training in medicinal chemistry and preparation of highly potent medicines from minerals and metals. It also deals with the principles and practice of Ayurvedic Pharmacy with its varied pharmaceutical methods and dosage forms.

Department of Agada Tantra and Vyavaharayurveda

Imparts training in toxicology, jurisprudence and forensic medicine, which explores the causes of unnatural behaviour and death. Ayurveda has nurtured and sustained a sophisticated system of toxicology that combats the effects of natural poisons posing long term or immediate threat to the continuity of the life process.

Department of Swasthyavritta

Imparts training on the principles and practice of Social and Preventative Medicine at both the personal and communal levels.

Department of Rachana Sharir (Anatomy)

The department of anatomy provides rigorous training in dissecting cadavers and critically examines both ancient and modern views on anatomy. The surgical school of Ayurveda pioneered the technique of treating dead bodies in flowing water and exposing the underlying structures by scraping the skin using soft instruments to gain accurate knowledge of minute structures that make up the human body.

Department of Dravyaguna

Deals with principles of Ayurvedic pharmacognosy and pharmacology with a special focus on identification of controversial drugs, adulterants and substitutes used in Ayurvedic practice. Ayurveda has developed a unique approach to understanding pharmacology of natural substances through meticulous analysis of taste, physico-chemical properties, potency and bio-transformation of the drug.

Admission Criteria :-

Eligibility : Intermediate with a minimum of 50% marks including Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Student must have cleared **NEET Examination** in the same year of taking Admission

Course Duration : Four Years Six Months and One Year internship.

Age limit- 17 to 25 year

Relaxation of 5 years in the upper age limit for SC, ST, OBC, PH candidates.

SCOPE OF AYURVEDA

The scope of Ayurveda is increasingly overlapping with other medical systems, not only in India but around the world. PANCHAKARMA

It is one of the unique therapeutic module to treat most of the chronic diseases that brings the equilibrium of doshas in the body by removing the toxins from the body by different shodhan procedures. The five karma of panchkarma are :

Vamana: It is therapeutic emesis which is best treatment for the ailment caused by kapha or kapha with pitta

Virechana: It is therapeutic purgation which treats ailments due to pitta and vata.

Basti karma: It is well known medicated enema. This karma helps to pacify vata disorders.

Nasya: It is administration of drug through nasal route. Nasya therapy helps to treat the disorders of head and neck

Raktamokshana: Blood letting or rakta mokshana is an ancient method to treat blood borne diseases. This therapy is commonly used for acne etc.

Other than these five karma, some other therapies like abhyanga, swedana, patra pinda swedana, kati basti etc are also part of panchakarma therapy.



OPD

Patients are registered at the reception and are seen on first come, first serve basis, however out of turn consultation may be provided in case of emergency and senior citizen. Patients have the right to consult any doctor. In OPD, clinical consultation is provided to patients which includes history taking, clinical examination, diagnosis and providing prescription to patients besides advising laboratory tests in some cases. OPD has a waiting hall with chairs, a TV, public utilities like drinking water and toilets. Sub waiting areas are available in front of individual consultation rooms. Wheel chairs, trolleys and attendants are there to help very sick patients.

IPD

Well equipped (100 Bedded I.P.D) having General wards, Private wards, ICU and NICU.



ICU

COER hospital has well equipped ICU (Intensive Care Unit) with all health care support system like ventilator, Bipap machine, oxygen concentrators, Emergency Medicine with the team of well experienced doctors to cater all emergency situations like (X-MDR) Multi Drug Resistant Tuberculosis, Post traumatic care, surgeries, etc.

NICU

New born babies who need intensive medical care are often put in a special care area of the hospital called The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.

Neonatal refers to the first 28 days of life (4 weeks). Equipments available in NICU is Incubator to maintain environment condition for a Neonate, Blood Pressure Monitor, Oxygen hood for respiratory system, Ventilator to improve lungs and respiratory function.

Hospital facility or unit staffed are equipped to provide continuous mechanical ventilatory support for a newborn infant. Care is given in an intensive care nursery for seriously ill neonates who require intensive skilled management by nursing and medical staff.

The following equipment are recommended for care of the critically ill : intensive care incubator or unit with overhead heating, respiratory or apnoeal monitor, heart rate monitor, intra vascular blood pressure transducer or surface blood pressure , recorder, transcutaneous pO₂ monitor or intravascular oxygen transducer, etc.



IMAGING AND RADIOLOGY

Radiology is a branch of medicine that uses imaging technology to diagnose and treat disease.

Radiology may be divided into two different areas, diagnostic radiology and interventional radiology. Doctors who specialize in radiology are called radiologists.

DIAGNOSTIC RADIOLOGY

Diagnostic radiology helps health care providers see structures inside your body. Doctors that specialize in the interpretation of these images are called diagnostic radiologists. Using the diagnostic images, the radiologist or other physicians can often:

- Diagnose the cause of your symptoms
- Monitor how well your body is responding to a treatment you are receiving for your disease or condition
- Screen for different illnesses, such as breast cancer, colon cancer, or heart disease

The most common types of diagnostic radiology examination include X-Ray and Ultrasound.

Physiotherapists work with the multidisciplinary team of healthcare providers at COER Hospital to provide holistic care that is aligned with our patients' goals. 7. A scaled down version of Gyms in all hostels.



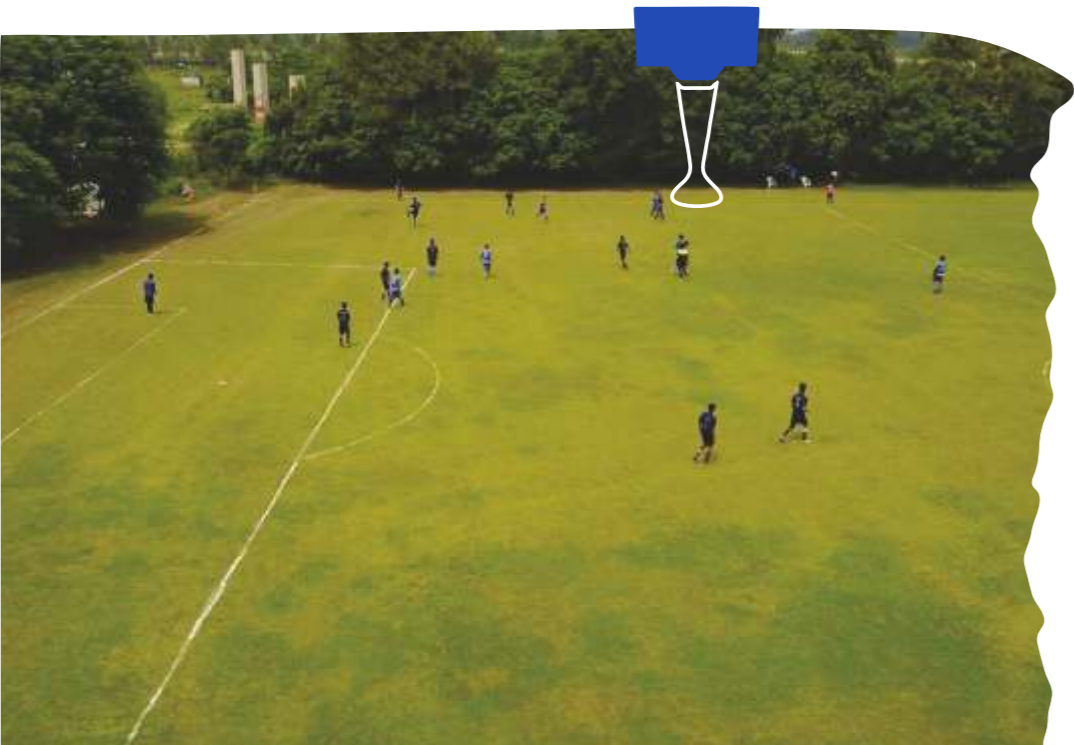
ANTI - RAGGING MEASURES

LABORATORIES

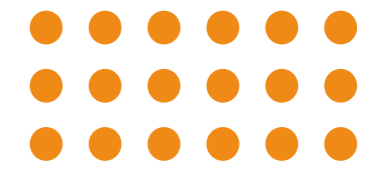
