- Define the purpose and goals of the event, and identify the target audience.
- Develop a detailed event plan, including the timeline, budget, and logistics requirements.
- Identify and recruit event staff and volunteers, and assign roles and responsibilities.
- Develop a marketing and communication strategy to promote the event, using appropriate channels such as social media, email etc.
- Secure necessary permits and approvals, and ensure compliance with relevant policies and regulations.
- All communications with the speaker/resource person must be on mail.
- Notice of the event must be displayed through the COERU notice board.

During Event

- Ensure all staff and volunteers are aware of their roles and responsibilities, and have the necessary resources and equipment.
- Monitor and manage event activities, including registration, seating, and activities.
- Provide necessary support and resources to quests and participants.
- Gather feedback from attendees and incorporate suggestions for improvement
- Get Testimonials from the speaker/resource person.
- Photographs of the event are compulsory; therefore make sure to get your event covered through the photographer.
- All forms (attendance, testimonial, feedbacks) must be signed by the event coordinator and Head of the department/convenor.

Post-Event

- Evaluate the success of the event against the defined goals and objectives.
- Conduct a financial review and finalize event expenses and revenue.
- Archive all event-related documents and data for future reference.

ENGINEER'S DAY



PHARMACIST DAY



FACULTY QUALITY MONITORING

Feedback System: The primary purpose of a student's feedback system is to evaluate the performance of teachers, identify areas for improvement, and enhance the overall quality of education.

After collecting feedback, the data is analyzed to identify trends and areas where teachers excel or need improvement & help in taking decisions related to faculty development, curriculum design, and overall program improvement. COERU has a system of taking the feedback from students twice in a semester after the completion of first and second mid term exams.

Quality Academic **AQMS:** Management System run by COERU is a mechanism through which a regular check on the quality of teaching and learning is done. Its fundamental principle is continuous improvement. This system consists of class buddies giving feedback weekly for the classes held in that week. Providing opportunities for faculty development and training is an essential component of AQMS to ensure that educators are equipped with the skills necessary knowledge to deliver high-quality education.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

FDP: On the basis of data obtained from the AQMS and feedback system, Faculty Development Programs are organized by the IQAC and by the different departments in collaboration with IQAC.

- 1.Five Days (FDP) on "Teaching and Learning Methodology amid the Paradigm Shift in Higher Education".
- 2. Five Days (FDP) on "Cyber Security" under the aegis of Uttarakhand Science Education & Research Centre (USERC).

IOAC also motivates the faculty members to enhance their skills at individual level. This includes getting certified courses from NPTEL, ATAL, Coursera etc. Faculty members are motivated by the reward provided to them for their good performances in these FDP.



Thirty-four faculty members at COERU have been awarded certificates successfully completing their courses through NPTEL. Additionally, two faculty members achieved positions within 5% of performers the top in their respective courses.
